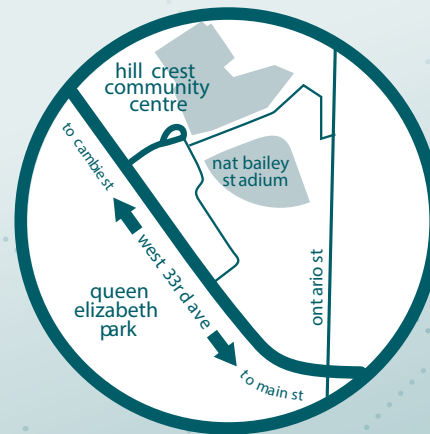

COURSE OUTLINE

These seminar based study clubs will explore diagnosis and treatment planning and various fixed prosthodontic options to restore individual teeth and the partially edentulous patients. Participants will be encouraged to present interesting cases for discussion with the group. A closing dinner in May is a highlight of this Study Club.
