Digital Dentistry - What You Need To Know About the What, How and Why

This session will aim to provide you with the crucial components of what is available to us today. We will explore the many aspects of how technology is improving patient care and look at practical ways to incorporate the various parts of technology into your practice. The use of technology in everyday dentistry is ever increasing. Patients are demanding it because it provides us with the tools to provide better outcomes. Digital dentistry touches every part of what we do. Therefore awareness of what is out there and what is to come is not only becoming increasingly more important, but knowledge of it is essential.



Dr. Jonathan A. Ng, BMedSc, DDS, MSc, Dip. Pros., FRCD(C) is a Certified Specialist in Prosthodontics. He obtained his Doctor of Dental Surgery Degree from the University of Alberta and his Prosthodontic specialty at the

University of British Columbia. His private practice is in Vancouver, Canada where Dr. Ng specializes in complex prosthodontic care and rehabilitation, which includes the surgical placement of implants, implant prostheses, as well as fixed and removable prostheses. Dr. Ng is also on staff as a Prosthodontist at the BC Cancer Agency treating medically complex patients. Dr. Ng works closely with the emerging technology and has written a thesis and published numerous articles on the topic of digital dentistry. As such, Dr. Ng offers a perspective of the current technology that is up-to-date and evidence based.

Aesthetics & Function of Ceramic Restorations

Dr. Chris Wyatt

Patients are increasingly demanding “Perfect Smiles” as a result of social pressures for aesthetically pleasing, beautifully formed, and well-aligned white teeth. How do we, as dentists providing restorations for individual teeth, replacement of missing teeth, and complete mouth rehabilitations satisfy these demands? The use of modern ceramics has opened the opportunity for dentists to design and deliver beautiful restorations, teeth, and enhanced smiles. “Aesthetics & Function” is the key to the success of all dental work including ceramic veneers, crowns, and bridges. I will cover aesthetics concepts, dental materials, occlusion, and longevity of ceramic restorations and complete rehabilitations. An emphasis will be placed upon the clinical use of the new aesthetic restorative materials including zirconium dioxide and lithium disilicate glass ceramics.



Chris Wyatt, BSc, DMD, MSc, FRCD(C), Dip Pros, is a Certified Specialist in Prosthodontics and a Professor and Head of the Division of Prosthodontics and Dental Geriatrics at the University of British Columbia, Faculty of Dentistry.

He has published numerous papers in the field of prosthodontics, implant dentistry, dental caries, and geriatrics. In 1998, Dr. Wyatt was the recipient of the Killam Teaching Award and is the 2009 recipient of the W.W. Wood Award for “Excellence in Dental Education.” Dr. Wyatt is past President of the Association of Prosthodontists of Canada and the BC Society of Prosthodontists, and is an active member of the Canadian Dental Association, British Columbia Dental Association, and the College of Dental Surgeons of British Columbia. In addition to lecturing and providing continuing education courses on Prosthodontics within and outside of Canada, he enjoys treating patients with prosthodontic concerns in his private practice.

Endodontics: Contemporary Root Canal Instrumentation and Obturation

In addition to locating and negotiating canals, Glide Path development is an essential element prior to performing mechanized root canal instrumentation. Tips on how to navigate to, and maintain, working length, will be presented, as well as various ways to develop a proper Glide Path. Over the past several years, there have been several modifications to Nickel Titanium instruments used to prepare root canals. There have been changes in NiTi metallurgy, shape and design, as well as new rotary and reciprocating mechanized files. An update on the various NiTi file systems and how to choose the one best suited for the tooth being treated, will be presented. Obturation materials have advanced beyond hand-rolled gutta percha cones and eugenol based sealer. Gutta percha cones are machined, and many specifically match the dimensions of the instruments used to shape the canals. Sealers vary widely from resin based to bioceramic. An overview of the different Gutta Percha systems, as well as the different root canal sealers will be addressed.



Jeffrey M. Coil, DMD, MSD., PhD., FRCD(C), FADI, FACD, is a Certified Specialist in Endodontics, and is the Director of Graduate Endodontics, at the University of British Columbia, Faculty of Dentistry. He received his undergraduate,

dental and doctorate degrees from UBC, and his Graduate Endodontic training at the University of Washington. He is an editorial consultant for the CDA Journal and on the Scientific Advisory Board for the Journal of Endodontics. He is past president of the Canadian Academy of Endodontics, and mentors the Northwest Endodontic Study Club and Seminar.
