Program Outline

**Over 300 hours of Continuing Education**

The AAID Vancouver MaxiCourse® is a structured program consisting of 30 days of education over ten months. The program runs from September through June. Each Module runs from Friday to Sunday, consisting of a systematic buildup of didactic material, laboratory exercises, surgical demonstrations, clinical participation, and surgeries on your own patients. All surgeries are mentored and supervised by AAID board-certified faculty members in the UBC Faculty of Dentistry grad specialty clinic. Module four of the program offers an opportunity to review surgical anatomy as well as the placement of implants and performance of various surgical procedures on cadavers at the UBC Faculty of Medicine, Department of Anatomy.

At the completion of the program, each participant will be eligible to challenge the written component of the AAID Fellowship exam. This is optional and a personal choice.
