

COURSE OUTLINE

This course provides instruction in orthodontic examination, diagnosis, and treatment-planning with emphasis on the goals, objectives, and realistic expectations of orthodontic treatment. Didactic instruction will be supplemented with clinical demonstrations, treatment case examples from a broad practice data-base, and "hands-on" experiences. Upon completion, participants should be able to:

1. Effectively evaluate the severity of malocclusions,
2. Assess and anticipate the degree of treatment difficulty
3. Critically evaluate the quality of orthodontic treatments, and
4. Select and effectively treat those conditions appropriate for their level of training and experience

Completion of this program provides participants the opportunity to proceed to the advanced-level clinical participation courses in orthodontics currently offered by Continuing Dental Education at the University of British Columbia, on a space availability basis.
