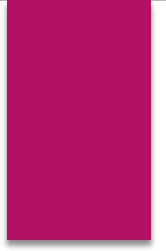

Getting to know you through your profile

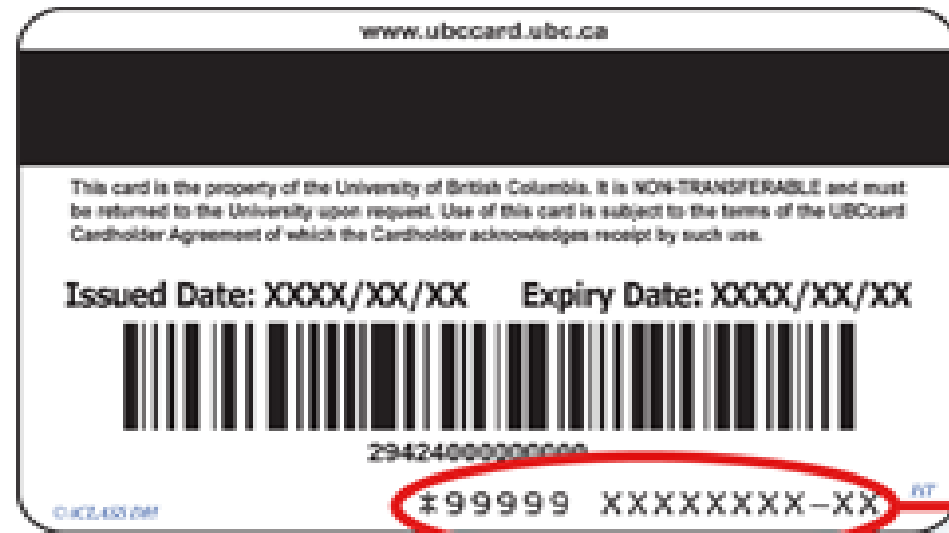
- Instructors will use the class photos to get to know you, especially important as you start working in clinic

DH Faculty Advisors

- ▶ DHDC Faculty Advisors are knowledgeable experienced Instructors who are familiar with the program, and are able to advise on a range of issues, or point you in the right direction.
- ▶ Available informally or by appointment; they can advise about issues such as:
