



# Immunization reviews

- UBC Health and our community partners require all Dentistry students to complete a review of their immunization status through UBC Student Health. Make your appointment as soon as possible, (for when you will be in town).
- To schedule an appointment with SHS, call (604) 822-7011. (please refer to the letter we sent).
- You will need to take along all your records and all pertinent laboratory reports, along with the completed Immunization form.
- Please keep in mind that you may require more than one appointment, Many students will require boosters, additional tests and/or immunizations – all of which takes time. All of your appointments should be completed by end of December latest, so you can attend clinic.




